

**(iii) Provision for economic & social rehabilitation of the victims of the Atrocities.**

There are at present two cases of atrocities committed on the tribals. The fund provided under Centrally Sponsored Scheme is available to meet the expenditure towards social and economic rehabilitation of the victims, if any.

**(iv) Appointment for officers for initiating or exercising supervision or prosecutions for the contravention of the provisions of the act.**

As there are two cases of atrocities, no such appointment is necessary.

**(v) Setting up of committees at such appropriate levels as the State Government may think fit to assist the Government in formulating or implementing of such measures.**

No committee is necessary taking into account the number of cases of the atrocities.

**(vi) Provisions for a periodic survey of the working of the provision of the act.**

No survey is considered necessary as the number of cases of atrocities is only two.

**(vii) Identification of atrocity prone areas.**

There is no atrocity prone area in this UT. So no measures were needed for safety of the STs. They were well protected in the tribal areas under the existing law.
