I am directed to say that the Government of India has instituted the National Award for being given annually to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and/or individual Human Rights Activists who have done outstanding fieldwork in the area of eradicating untouchability and in combating offences of atrocities under the Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955 (PCR Act) and the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (POA Act). It is also requested that proposals regarding nominations of the prospective awardees for the year 2007 may kindly be furnished to this Ministry with the approval of the Chief Minister/Lt. Governor immediately latest by 31st October, 2007.
