		5(1) No member of an aboriginal tribe shall, except with the previous sanction of the Chief Commissioner, transfer by way of sale, exchange mortgage, lease or otherwise any land to any person other than a member of an aboriginal tribe.
		 (2) No land held or occupied by a member of an aboriginal tribe shall be liable to attachment or sale in execution of any decree or order of a civil or revenue court. (3) Any transfer, attachment or sale of any land made in contravention of this section shall be void.
		(4) No person other than a member of an aboriginal tribe shall, except with the previous sanction of the Chief Commissioner, acquire any interest in any land situated in a reserved area or in any product of or crop raised on, such land or shall except under and in accordance with the terms and conditions of a licence granted by the Chief commissioner, carry on any trade or business in any such area.
		In view of above mentioned provisions in the Regulation, no land alienation has taken place in this UT so far.
