

SOCIAL DEMANDS

- 1 Issuance of a postal stamp in the name of BABA JEEWAN SINGH RANGHRETA and declaration of public holiday on his birth anniversary.
- 2 Abolition of the practice of privatization of the services of the scavengers and sweepers in all the organizations which are coming under the Administrative control of Central and State Government.
- 3 Declaration of post of sweepers /Safai Karmcharies as technical service to ensure to give them time bound promotion and sufficient compensation to the victims of accidental cases of death in the severages. And after completion of 6 months of probation period, the service should be made permanent.
- 4 The Control and Management of the Valmiki Temple known as "Ram Tirath" situated at Amritsar, Punjab should be handed over to the Maharshi Valmiki Trust for effective development as honoring the sentiments of the entire Valmiki Community.
- 5 Effective implementation of the centrally sponsored schemes of providing permanent rehabilitation and building of houses for the home less Valmiki and scavenging community by granting at least 200 sq. yards plot to them along with the right of ownership especially in the urban and rural areas.
- 6 Declaration and launching of special drive for providing employment to the educated unemployed youth of Valmiki and scavenging community for especially in Railway and other Central departments.
- 7 Mandatory appointments/nominations of the eminent persons of the Valmiki and Scavenging Community in the National Commission for Safai karamchari and National Safai Karamchari Financial Development Corporation at the central as well as at the state level.
- 8 Government/Grama-Sabha land wherever available be exclusively allotted to the Valmiki/scavenger community for their use as per their need. If Govt. land is not available the Central/State Government should provide the land
- 9 Name of a National University/Educational Institution should be in the name of Bhagwan Valmiki
- 10 The birthday/Jayanthi of Maharshi Valmiki should be declared as National Holiday
