4. "Initiatives of ANI Administration towards mainstreaming of Jarawas and Policies for different tribes of A&N Islands"

There are six Schedule Tribes in these islands, who constitute 7.5 % of the population. Except Nicobarese, the other five are Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups. The Administration has notified 56% of the total land of the islands as Tribal Reserve Area. The Andamanese and Onges who got decimated during the British India era, have now been rehabilitated in Strait island and Dugong Creek at Little Andaman island respectively.

The other tribes namely Jarawas, Sentenelese and Shompens are living inside the forested tribal reserve area and carry out hunting and gathering activities. The Aministration is providing safety, security and welfare of the tribes by a policy of minimum intervention and thereby ensuring maximum autonomy to the Tribes within their habitat.
