		<p>Management Plan, 1991 for next two years or till new plans (IIMP & CZMP as per CRZ, 2011) are finalized. It will help the Administration in completing the old projects. The Lt. Governor requested that these projects should be allowed to continue at least in major islands.</p> <p>Adviser, M/o Environment & Forest (MOEF) said that they have not received the proposal so far and are waiting for the proposal from the islands. Lt. Governor said that they have requested the Minister for an extension of two years. The Adviser M/o E&F reiterated it has been clarified in the Group of Officers meeting convened by Cabinet secretariat that four islands have been given clearance while the proposal in respect of other projects have not been received by them. She assured necessary action as soon as the same is received from the Administration.</p>	<p>Regulation Zone Notification, 1991 shall be valid for a period of twenty four months, unless the aforesaid period is extended by Ministry of Environment and Forests. As the completion of Integrated Island Management Plans is likely to take time, a request was made in the meeting of National Coastal Zone Management Authority held on 27.11.2012 to consider extension of the period of validity of the Coastal Zone Management Plan's already approved by the Ministry for a further period of two years. However, National Coastal Zone Management Authority in its 26th Meeting recommended extension of one year period for submission of Integrated Island Management Plans /Island Coastal Regulation Zone Plans by Andaman and Nicobar Administration.</p> <p>Follow up action:</p> <p>A DO letter was sent to Secretary, Ministry of Environment and Forests by Principal Secretary (E&F), A N Administration on 07.01.2013, which was followed by a DO letter from the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration on 21.01.2013 Hon'ble Lt.
