

- would send a note on the issue to Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), which would then take up the issue with the Ministry of Finance (MoF) for resolution.
3. Ministry of HRD and HRD Division, Planning Commission would initiate action on the issue of recruitment of 196 teachers in ANI and apprise IDA about the same in one month.
 4. Both the UT Administration need to take up the issue of increasing the quota of seats for MBBS with the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in time so that the matter is take up for academic year 2014-15. If the requested is turned down by the Ministry in time, then it may be considered for IDA again.
 5. Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) may take up the issue of transfer of committed liabilities from Plan to Non-Plan with the Ministry of Finance (MoF).

As regards the actionable agenda issues for the 14th IDA meeting, the following action posts emerged after detailed deliberations:

1. Air Connectivity: The issue related to air connectivity is very important and deserves the intervention of the Prime Minister. The ANI Administration would give a detailed note on the issue of air connectivity indicating the number of commercial flights operated and passengers during both lean and peak season, costs involved in having chartered flights, the proportion of LTC passengers etc so as to pin point the exact decision area for the resolution of the issue.
2. The ANI Administration would also send a note on subsidy provision for operating chartered flights and the same would be discussed as part of Plan discussion for 2014-15.
3. The issue of expansion of airport at Agatti only needs to be taken forward and may not be taken to IDA. The present status is the UTL would hand over 17.6 acres of land free of all encumbrances to AAI/ Ministry of Civil Aviation by March, 2014; AAI would complete the DPR and EFC by April/ May, 2014 and submit it to MoCA, which would then finalizing funding aspects and take the matter forward including.
