Estt. A & N Tribal Research & Training Institute (ANTRI):

The A & N Tribal Research & Training Institute (ANTRI) has been set up vide Administrative Order No. 273 dated 16.8.2013, to provide important planning inputs to A & N Administration by conducting research and evaluation studies based on primary data. A Research Advisory Board has been constituted comprising with Secretary (TW) as Convener, Dr Kanchan Mukhopadhaya, Supdt. Anthrapologist (Cultural), AnSI, Prof. Vishvajit Pandaya, a well known Anthropologist, Shri SA Awaradi and Shri Manish Chandi, subject Experts as Member of Research Advisory Board for ANTRI. The tenure of the Research Advisory Board will be for a period of three years. To make the institute functional from 2.10.2013 onwards, Research Associate (02),Librarian (01) and Computer Assistant (01), were recruited on contract basis. A vacant Govt. building in Haddo, Port Blair town was earmarked for setting up of ANTRI building and made
