The research team submitted its findings entitled "Jarawa movements in relation to time and space" to the Administration.  The next phase of work in the Jarawa reserve territory will be carried out
		through the Hot Spots. The process of setting up of Hot Spots at the following places viz Bada Balu, Jhao Kona, Tirur and Potatang in South Andaman and Phooltala, Lewis Inlet and Bluff Island in Middle and North Andaman is being taken, and once the structure for Hot Spots at the respective places come up and become operational the second phase of work on the Jarawa study including empowerment will begin.
