

different seat, fourteen days from the last of those dates, he resigns all but one of the seats by writing under his hand addressed to the Director of Tribal Council Elections and the Commission, all the seats shall become vacant.

## CHAPTER-XVI

## PUBLICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

108. Publication of results of general elections to Tribal Councils: Where a general election is held for the purpose of constituting a new Tribal Council, there shall be notified by the Commission in the official Gazette, as soon as may be, after the results of the election in all the constituencies other than those in which the poll could not be taken for any reason on the date originally fixed under clause (d) of rule 36 or for which the time for completion of the election has been extended under the provisions of these rule, have been declared by the returning officer, the names of the members elected for those constituencies and upon the issue of such notification that Tribal Councils shall be deemed to be duly constituted:

Provided that the issue of such notification shall not be deemed-

- (a) To preclude ---
  - (i) the taking of the poll and the completion of the election in any constituency or constituencies in which the poll could not be taken for any reason on the date originally fixed under clause (d) of rule 36; or
  - (ii) the completion of the election in any constituency or constituencies for which time has been extended under the provisions of these rule; or
- (b) to affect the duration of the Tribal Council functioning immediately before the issue of the said notification.

## CHAPTER-XVII

## MISCELLANEOUS

- 109. Custody of "Ballot Boxes" and papers to election:
  - (2) All "Ballot Boxes" used at the election shall be kept in such custody as the Director of Tribal Council Elections may direct.
  - (3) The returning officer shall keep in safe custody-
    - (a) the packets of unused ballot papers with counterfoils attached thereto;
    - (b) the packets of the used ballot paper whether valid, tendered or rejected;
    - (c) the packets of the counterfoils of used ballot paper;
    - (d) the packets of the marked copy of the electoral roll; and
    - (e) all other paper relating to the election.
