(1) Any member of a Village Council may resign his office by giving notice in writing to that effect to the First Captain and such resignation shall take effect from the date of its receipt by the First Captain. (2) The Second Captain may resign his office by giving notice in writing to the First Captain, but the resignation shall not take effect unless it is accepted by the Village Council. (3) The First Captain may resign his office by giving notice in writing to the Assistant Commissioner but the resignation shall not take effect until it is accepted by him.	Resignation from office
20. (1) A motion of 'no confidence' against the First Captain may be moved by any member of a Village Council after giving a notice thereof in such manner as may be prescribed. (2) A special meeting of the Village Council shall be convened within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the motion has been moved to deliberate on and decide the no confidence motion. (3) If the motion of 'no confidence' is carried by a majority of the total membership of the Village Council, the Village Council shall recommend to the Village General Body, the removal of the First Captain from his office. (4) On receipt of the recommendation under sub-section (3), a special meeting of the Village General Body shall be convened with a quorum of not less than one fifth of the total membership of the Village General Body and the recommendation shall be approved by the majority of members present and voting. (5) Upon the approval of the recommendation under sub-section (4) the First Captain shall cease to hold office from the date on which the recommendation is approved.
