(6) If the recommendation of the Village Council is not approved or there is no quorum in the special meeting of the Village General Body, no fresh motion of 'no confidence' shall be moved against the First Captain in the Village Council within a period of one year from the date on which the recommendation fails to acquire approval of the Village General Body or the date on which the recommendations could not be considered for lack of quorum.	
(7) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the First Captain shall not preside over a meeting of the Village Council convened under Subsection (2) and of the Village General Body under subsection (4), but he shall have the right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meetings.	
21. (1) A motion of 'no confidence' may be moved by any member of the Village Council against the Second Captain after giving notice in such manner as may be prescribed.	Motion of no confidence against Second Captain.
(2) A special meeting of the Village Council shall be convened within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the motion has been moved to deliberate on and decide the 'no confidence' motion.	
(3) If the motion is carried by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the total number of members of the Village Council, the Second Captain shall cease to hold office from the date on which the motion is carried.	
(4) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the Second Captain shall not preside over a meeting in which a motion of no confidence is discussed against him, but he shall have the right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meetings.	
22. Any casual vacancy in the seat of the Village Council or in the office of the First or the Second Captain, shall be filled for the remainder of the duration of the Village Council, by election in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation;	Casual vacancy

Provided that where a seat or the office of the First Captain has been reserved for a woman, no person other than a woman shall be qualified to be elected to fill such vacancy.
