The Executive Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Prothra Pur has further stated that the Panchayat Samiti has the power and authority to function as an Institution of Self Government in respect of the preparation of plans for economic development and social justice in relation to the matters listed in the Fifth Schedule of the Panchayat Regulation, besides it make provision for carrying out within the area of its jurisdiction any other work or measure which is likely to promote the health, safety, education, comfort, convenience or social or economic well being of the persons residing in its jurisdiction. The Gram Panchayat has the powers and authority to function as an Institution of Self Government in respect of the preparation of plans for economic development and social justice in relation to the matters listed in the Second Schedule of the Panchayat Regulation, besides it make provision for carrying out within the area of the Gram any other work or measure which is likely to promote the health, safety, education, comfort, convenience or social or economic well being of the residents of the Gram.

As per provisions contained in the A & N islands (Tribal Councils) Regulation, 2009, the Island Council has the power and authority to function as an Institution of Self Government in respect of the preparation of plans for economic development and social justice in relation to the matters listed in the Third Schedule of the Tribal Council Regulation, besides it make provisions for carrying out within the area of its jurisdiction any other work or measure which is likely to promote the health, safety, education, comfort, convenience or social or economic well being of the persons residing in its jurisdiction. The Village Council has the authority to function as an Institution of Self Government in respect of the matters specified in the Second Schedule of the Tribal Council Regulation, besides it make provision for carrying out within the area of the village, any other work or measure which is likely to promote the health, safety, education, comfort, convenience or social or economic well being of the residents of the village.
