(2) The Executive Officer shall attend every meeting of the Island Council and shall have the right to attend the meeting of a committee thereof and to take part in the discussion but shall not have a right to move a resolution or to vote. If in the opinion of the Executive	
Officer any proposal before the Island Council is violative of or inconsistent with provisions of this Regulation, or any other law, rule or order made thereunder, it shall be his duty to bring the same to the notice of the Island Council.
