Certain actions, as mentioned hereinunder, coming within the purview of the Administration, are to be initiated at your end

1. The A&N Administration may like to publish the said Regulation in the Official Gazette of A & N Administration, as per procedure.
2. Relevant Rules have to be made for Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections, which shall govern the de-limitation of physical limits of various constituencies, viz. Ward Member Constituencies, Village Councils and Island Councils and Administrative Rules for running day to day Administration of the Tribal Councils.
3. Once the said Rules are framed and published in the official Gazette, the physical limits of various constituencies are to be marked on the field and Electoral Rolls prepared accordingly, as per quasi-judicial procedure.
4. The logistics for physical measurement / fixing of boundaries/limits need to be provided well in time for preparation of maps of various constituencies. The fact that there are no authenticated map showing the exact boundaries of different tribal villages, is to be borne in mind while planning.
