(1) The Village Council shall place before the Village General Body at its meeting in April or May -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the annual statement of accounts; (b) the report of the administration of the preceding financial year; (c) the development and other programmes of work proposed for that financial year; and (d) the previous audit notes and replies made thereto. <p>(2) It shall be open to the Village General Body to discuss any or all the matters placed before it under sub-section (1) and the Village Council shall consider the suggestions, if any, so made by the Village General Body.</p> <p>(3) A Village General Body shall carry out such other functions as the Administrator may, by a general or special order, require.</p>	
	<p>CHAPTER - III VILLAGE COUNCIL</p>	
	<p>11. (1) As soon as may be after its constitution under Section 3, every Village General Body shall elect from amongst themselves the First Captain and the members of the Village Council through direct elections.</p> <p>(2) A Village Council shall consist of such number of seats, including the First Captain, not being less than five and more than nine, as the Deputy Commissioner may determine.</p> <p>(3) The ratio between the population of the territorial area of a Village Council and the number of seats in that Council to be filled by election shall, as far as practicable, be the same throughout the District;</p>	Constitution of Village Council.
