	<p><b>72.</b> The Administrator may entrust the Island Council with the execution, maintenance or repair of any work or the management of any institution on behalf of the Government or local authority:</p> <p>Provided that the funds necessary for the execution or repair of the work or the management of the institution so entrusted to the Island Council shall be placed at the disposal of the Island Council by the Administrator or such local authority.</p>	Transfer of any work or institution to Island Council
	<p><b>73.</b> Every contract or agreement entered into by an Island Council shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Chief Captain, Executive Officer and by one other member of the Island Council and sealed with the common seal of the Island Council.</p>	Execution of contract.
