

	<b>89.</b> If any dispute arises between two or more Island Councils, it shall be referred to the Secretary Tribal Welfare of the Union Territory whose decision in the matter shall be final.	
	<b>90.</b> The Administrator or the Secretary Tribal Welfare or the Deputy Commissioner may call for and examine the records of the proceedings of any officer or Island Council for the purpose of satisfying himself as to the legality or propriety of any order passed and may revise or modify the order as he may deem fit. 	<b>CHAPTER - VIII</b>  <b>DISTRICT PLANNING COMMITTEE</b>	
	<b>91.</b> The Administrator shall constitute for the District, a District Planning Committee, under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner with such composition as may be prescribed. The Chief Captains of Island Councils shall be members of the District Planning Committee ex-officio.	
	<b>92.</b> The District Planning Committee shall prepare Five Year Plans and Annual Plan, in co-ordination with the Govt. Departments and other agencies in the District for the development of the area under its jurisdiction. The Chairperson of DPC shall forward the Development plan for the District as recommended by the Committee, to the Secretary Tribal Welfare.	
	<b>93.</b> The District Planning Committee shall follow such procedures as may be prescribed.	
	<b>CHAPTER - IX</b>  <b><u>ELECTION COMMISSION AND FINANCE</u></b> <b><u>COMMISSION</u></b>	
	<b>94.</b> (1) The Election Commission shall comprise the Election Commissioner appointed by the President of India under the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) Regulation 1994 and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Municipal) Regulation, 1994 in whom the superintendence, direction and control of the preparation of electoral rolls for, and the conduct of elections to the Village Councils and Island Councils in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, under this Regulation, shall be vested.
