(Ju)

- (y) "Schedule" means a schedule to this Regulation;
- (aa) "Section" means section of this Regulation;
- (ab) "Sessions Judge" means the Sessions, Judge of Andaman and Nicobar Islands;
- (ac) "Suit" means a civil suit trial by a Judicial Council;
- (ad) "Tax" means a tax, cess, rate or other import leviable under this Regulation;
- (ae) "Union Territory" means the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands;
- (af) "Vice-Councillor" means Vice-Councillor of a Judicial Council;
- [2] (ag) "Village level tribal council means" a Village Level Tribal Council constituted under sub-section (iii) of section (11)
- (ah) "1st Captain / 2nd Captain" means 1st Captain / 2nd Captain of a village level tribal council elected under relevant sections of this Regulations.
- (ai) "Chief Captain / Vice-Chief Captain", mean Chief Captain / Vice-Chief Captain of an Island Level Tribal Council elected under relevant sections of this regulation.
 - (aj) "Tuhet" means and include the Nicobarese traditional extended joint family.

CHAPTER-II

VILLAGE GENERAL BODY

- 3. The Administrator shall by Notification in the Official Gazette constitute general body for each village or group of villages within the area of a Village Council.
- 4.(i) A Village General Body shall consist of persons registered in the electoral roll relating to area of a Village Council.

Provided that a person shall be disqualified from being member of the General Body if he

- (a) is less than 18 years of age;
- (b) is not a citizen of India;
- (c) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by competent court; and
- (d) is not ordinarily a resident within the village for which the General Body is constituted.
- (ii) A person shall be deemed to be ordinarily resident in a village if ST has been ordinarily residing in such village or is in possession of a dwelling house therein ready for occupation.
