

- (iii) If the motion of no confidence is carried by a majority of the total membership of the Village Council, the Village Council shall recommend to the Village General Body, the removal of the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain from his office.
  - (iv) On receipt of recommendation under sub-section (iii) a special meeting of the Village General Body shall be convened with a quorum of not less than fifteen percent of the total membership of the Village General Body and the recommendation shall be approved by a majority of members present and voting.
  - (v) Upon the approval of the recommendation under sub-section (iv) the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain shall cease to hold office from the date on which the recommendation is approved.
  - (vi) If the recommendation of the Village Council is not approved or there is no quorum in the special meeting of the Village General Body, no fresh motion of no confidence shall be moved against: the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain in the Village Council within a period of one year from the date on which the recommendation fails to acquire approval of the Village General Body or the date on which the recommendations could not be considered for lack of quorum.
  - (vii) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain shall not preside over a meeting of Village Council concerned under Sub-section (ii) and of Village General Body under sub-section (iv), but he shall have a right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meetings.
- 21 22.(i) A motion of no confidence may be moved by any member of a Village Council against the 2<sup>nd</sup> Captain after giving such notice as may be prescribed.
- (ii) A special meeting of Village Council shall be convened within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the motion has been moved to deliberate on and decide the no confidence motion.
  - (iii) If the motion is carried by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the total number of members of the Village Council, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Captain shall cease to hold office from the date on which the motion is carried.
  - (iv) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Captain shall not preside over a meeting in which a motion of no confidence is discussed against him, but he shall have a right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meetings.
- 22 23. Any casual vacancy in the seat of the Village Councillor in the office of the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Captain shall be filled for the remainder of the duration of the Village Council by election in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation.

Provided that in the case of a seat or the office of the President reserved for a woman no person other than a woman shall be qualified to be chosen to fill such vacancy.
