

- (a) If the decree is for money, proceed to recover it as if it were an arrear of land revenue or
- (b) If the decree is for any specified movable property cause the decree to be executed as if it were a decree of a Civil Court and in so acting he may exercise all the powers of a civil court.
- 103. If the amount of fine or compensation under this Regulation is not fully paid the Village Judicial Council shall certify accordingly to the Assistant Commissioner and on receipt of such certificate the Assistant Commissioner proceed to recover it as if it were an arrear of land revenue and shall remit the amount so recovered to the Village Judicial Council.
- 104. As soon as the amount of fine or compensation referred to in section103 is realized by the Village Judicial Council, the amount so realized shall be entered in the prescribed register.
- 105. Every Village Judicial Council shall submit its annual report to the Administrator in such form and before such date as may be prescribed.

## CHAPTER-X (VII)

## ISLAND COUNCIL

- 106. The Administrator shall by notification in the Official Gazette constitute for the Islands in the Union Territory to which this Regulation applies, Council at the intermediate level to be called Island level Tribal Council.
- 107. (i)Every Island Council shall consist of such number of seats as the Administrator may by notification determine.
  - (ii) All the first, second and third captains for each village in an Island shall themselves form the Island Council who will elect among themselves the Chief Captain and Deputy Chief Captain
  - (iii) The Island Council shall exercise supervision over the Village Council. The disputes between the two villages shall be settled by the Island Judicial Council comprising of Chief Captain of Island Council, Deputy Chief Captain and first three captains of the concerned villages and any other person the Chief Captain may deem fit to decide the case.
  - (iv) The provisions of sub-sections (vi), (vii), and (viii) of section 11 shall so far as may be, apply to the Island Council as they apply to a Village Council subject to the modification that for the words "Village Council" wherever they occur, the words "Island Council" had been substituted & instead of term 1st Captain term Chief Captain is substituted.
