- (iii) A Island Council constituted upon the dissolution of a Island Council before the expiry of its duration shall continue only for the remainder of the period for which the dissolved Island Council would have continued under subsection(i) had it not been so dissolved.
- 69 115.(i) As soon as may be after the first meeting of the Island Council every member thereof shall take oath of office before the Deputy Commissioner in the form set out in the First Schedule.
- (ii) No member of the Island Council who has not taken such oath shall vote or take part in the proceedings of any meeting nor shall be included as a member of any committee constituted by the island Council.
- 62 116.(i) Any member of a Island Council may resign his office by giving notice in writing to that effect to the Chief Captain and such resignation shall take effect from the date of its receipt by the Chief Captain.
- (ii) The Vice-Chief Captain may resign his office by giving notice in writing to the Chief Captain but the resignation shall not take effect until it is accepted by the Island Council.
- (iii) The Chief Captain may resign his office by giving notice in writing to that effect to the Deputy Commissioner, but the resignation shall not take effect until it is accepted by him.
- 63 117.(i) A motion of no-confidence may be moved by any member of a Island Council against the Chief Captain or the Vice Chief Captain after such notice thereof as may be prescribed.
- (ii) If the motion is carried by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the total number of members of the Island Council, Chief Captain or Vice Chief Captain, as the case may be, shall cease to hold office from the date on which the motion is carried,
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the Chief Captain or the Vice-Chief Captain shall not preside over a meeting in which a motion of no-confidence discussed against him but he shall have the right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meeting,
- 64 118. Any casual vacancy in the office of the Chief Captain or Vice Chief Captain or a seat of a Island Council shall be filled for the remainder of the term by election in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation:
- Provided that, in case of a seat or the office of Chief Captain reserved for women, no person other than a women, as the case may be, shall be qualified to be chosen to fill such vacancy.
- 65 119.(i) The Administrator shall appoint a Officer of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration to be the Executive Officer for every Island Council.
