- (ii) Save as otherwise provided in section 187, 188, 189, 190 and 191 no civil court shall have jurisdiction to question the legality or validity of any action taken or decision given by the Election Commission or the Chief Secretary or the Deputy Commissioner in connection with the conduct of election under this Regulation.
- 193. The Assistant Commissioner in the case of Village Council and Deputy Commissioner in the case of Island Council and District Council may authorize any of his officers to enter in and inspect or cause to be entered and inspected any immovable property occupied by any Village Council or Island Council or District Council or any work in progress under the direction or such Village Council, Island Council or District Council the case may be.
- 194. (i) No action shall lie against any member, officer, servant or agent of a Village Council or a Judicial Council or a Island Council or District Council acting under the direction of such Village Council or Judicial Council or Island Council or District Council action in respect of anything done in good faith under this Regulation or any rule or byelaw made thereunder.
  - (ii) The provisions of the Judicial Officer's Protection Act, 1850. shall apply to the members of the Judicial Council.
  - No action shall be brought against any Village Councillor Island (iii) Councillor a Judicial Councillor a District Councillor a 1st Captain or 2nd Captain or Judicial Councillor or Deputy Judicial Councillor or Chief Captain or Vice-Chief Captain or Chief Councillor or Deputy Chief Councillor or any of their members, officers, servants or agents for anything done or purporting to be done under this Regulations and the rules and by-laws framed thereunder until the expiry of two months next after notice in writing has been left or delivered at the office of such Village Councillor Judicial Councillor Island Councillor District Council and also at the residence of such of their members, officers, servants or agents against whom action is intended to be brought. The notice shall state the cause of action, the nature or the relief sought, the amount of compensation, if any, claimed and the name and place of abode of the person who intends to bring the action.
  - (iv) Every such action shall be commenced within six months after the accrual of the cause of action and not afterwards.
- 195. Every member of the Village Council or a Judicial Council or Island Council or District Council and every officer land servant maintained by or employed under a Village Council or a Judicial Council or a Island Council or District Council shall be deemed to be a public servant within the meaning of section 21 of the Indian Penal Code.
- 196. No member of a Village Council or a Judicial Council or a Island Council or District Council or any of their officers having any duty to perform in connection with any sale under this Regulation, shall directly or indirectly bid for, or acquire any interest in any property sold at such sale.
