

- 426 Mischief.
- 428 Mischief by killing or maiming cattle, etc., of any value or any animal of the value of ten rupees
- 430 Mischief by injury to works of irrigation or wrongfully diverting public water.
- 447 Criminal trespass.
- 448 House trespass.
- 504 Intentional insult with the intent to provoke breach of peace.
- 506 Criminal intimidation.
- 509 Words, gesture, or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman.
- 510 Misconduct in public by a drunken person.

UNDER THE CATTLE TRESPASS ACT, 1871

- 24. Forcibly opposing the seizure of Cattle or reselling the same.
- 26. Causing damage by cattle to land crop and public road.

UNDER THIS REGULATION OR THE RULES AND BYE-LAWS
FRAMED THEREUNDER:

Any offence under this Regulation or any rule or bye-laws
framed thereunder.

UNDER ANY OTHER ENACTMENTS

Any such compoundable offence as may be notification be declared by
the Administrator, to be cognizable by a Judicial council.
