THE PAWI AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL (ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE) RULES, 19742.

Rules

to provide Administration of Justice within the Pawi Autonomous District.

PREAMBLE: Whereas it is expedient to make rules for the administration of justice in the Pawi Autonomous District and in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 4 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Pawi Autonomous District Council, with the previous approval of the Administrator of Mizoram, is pleased to make the following Rules, namely, the Pawi Autonomous District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1974.

PRELIMINARY

- Short title, extent and commencement :-1.
 - These rules may be called the Pawi Autonomous District Council (1)(Administration of Justice) Rules, 1974.
 - These Rules shall apply to the whole of the Pawi Autonomous District constituted under Government Notification No. LJD. 8/72/53 dt. (2) 29.4.72 read with the Pawi-Lakher Autonomous Region (Reorganisation) Order, 1972 under Notification NO. CCMP. 3/72/ 70.77 dt. 1.4.72.
 - They shall come into force at once and the courts constituted under (3) the Pawi-Lakher Autonomous Region (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1954 shall continue to function as if they were constituted under these rules.
 - Definition. In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant or the context 2. otherwise requires :-
 - "Government" means the Government of Mizoram 3 .
