

## The Lakher Autonomous District

*(Administration of Justice) Rules, 1981<sup>1</sup>*

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-paragraph (4) of the paragraph 4 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Lakher Autonomous District Council, with the previous approval of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Mizoram, is pleased to make the following rules, namely :-

### CHAPTER - I

#### PRELIMINARY

1. (1) These rules may be called the Lakher Autonomous District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1981.
- (2) These rules shall apply to the whole of the Lakher Autonomous District.
- (3) They shall come into force atonce.
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires -
  - (1) ["Government" means the State Government of Mizoram]<sup>2</sup>.
  - (2) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India;
  - (3) "Deputy Commissioner" means the Deputy Commissioner of Chhingtupui District;
  - (4) "District" means the Lakher Autonomous District;
  - (5) "District Council" means the District Council of the Lakher Autonomous District;
  - (6) "Executive Committee" means the Executive Committee of the Lakher District Council constituted under the provisions of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules 1974, and the term "Chief Executive Member" and "Members of Executive Committee" shall be construed accordingly.
  - (7) "Gazette" means the Mizoram Gazette;
  - (8) "High Court" means the Cauhati High Court, Gauhati;
