

Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974.

NOTES

A number of laws, though not strictly applied to the erstwhile P-L Autonomous Region, have been referred in these rules. In fact, legislation by such referential incorporation, are of two categories. First is the kind which by specific reference, incorporates the provisions of another statute as at the time of adoption. The second type of such referential incorporation is where a statute incorporates by general reference the law concerning a particular subject, as a genus. In the first type of statutes, the subsequent amendments of the referred law, cannot automatically apply with the referring statute. In the latter case, subsequent amendments of the referred statute are included in the referring law. - *BIJAYA VS. SMT. GOPIKA BAI*, AIR 1978 SC 793 (797).
