

(ii) If the motion is carried by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the total number of members of the Island Council, Chief Captain or Vice Chief Captain, as the case may be, shall cease to hold office from the date on which the motion is carried,

(iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the Chief Captain or the Vice-Chief Captain shall not preside over a meeting in which a motion of no-confidence discussed against him but he shall have the right to speak or otherwise take part in the proceedings of such meeting,

64. Any casual vacancy in the office of the Chief Captain or Vice Chief Captain or a seat of a Island Council shall be filled for the remainder of the term by election in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation:

Provided that, in case of a seat or the office of Chief Captain reserved for women, no person other than women, as the case may be, shall be qualified to be chosen to fill such vacancy.

- 65.(i) The Administrator shall appoint a Officer of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration to be the Executive Officer for every Island Council.

(ii) The Government may post from time to time to work under every Island Council such number of officers and officials of Group A or B or C or D services of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration (including any officer and official appointed to such service from amongst persons employed by existing (local authorities) to serve under the Island Council as the Administrator considers necessary,

(iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation or any other law for the time being in force, the Administrator or any officer or other authority authorized by him in this behalf shall have the power to effect transfer of the officers and officials so posted from one Island Council to another.

- 66.(i) Save as otherwise expressly provided by or under this Regulation the Executive Officer shall

- (a) exercise all the powers specifically imposed or conferred upon him by or under this Regulation or under any other law for the time being in force;
- (b) lay down the duties and supervise and control officers and officials of, or holding office under the Island Council in accordance with rules made by the Administrator;
- (c) supervise and control the execution of all works of the Island Councils;
- (d) take necessary measures for the speedy execution of all works and developmental schemes of the Island Council;
- (e) have custody of all papers and documents connected with the proceedings of the meetings of the Island Council and of its committees; .
