<p>vi) a number of terms e.g. Judicial Council or, Deputy Councillor, Village Judicial Council, First Captain Second Captain, Chief Captain etc. which have been used in the various provisions of the draft Regulation may need to be defined and numbered accordingly.</p>	<p>The terms Judicial Councilor, First Captain and Second Captain have been duly defined in the section 2 (r) of the proposed Regulation. It appears that the word Deputy Councilor is not found in the draft Regulation. The Village Judicial Council has been referred at various places as Judicial Council. Hence the term Judicial Council is proposed to be replaced by Village Judicial Council as defined under section 2 (s) by modifying the draft Regulation.</p>
<p>vii) uniformity in the definition and use of terms has not been maintained as many of them have been used differently in different places, for example, the term 'Village Level Tribal Council' is defined in clause (ag) of section 2 but referred to in certain provisions as 'Village Tribal Council', and in certain other provisions as Village</p>	<p>The comments of the Ministry has been taken on record and necessary corrections are being made by replacing Deputy Chief Captain by word Vice-Chief Captain.</p>
