and performing such other duties as may be prescribed.

- 61. Every Judicial Council shall have a seal bearing its name, the name of the Tehsil and the District in which it is constituted and all its decrees, order, proceedings and processes shall hear the seal of the Village Judicial Council.
- 62. The Judicial Councilor and the Deputy Judicial Councilor or a member of a Judicial Council may resign his office by giving a notice in writing under his hand to the Assistant Commissioner and his office shall there upon become vacant.
- 63.(1) The Deputy Commissioner may, after giving him an opportunity of being heard and for reasons to be recorded, remove any member of a Village Judicial Council if, in his opinion, such member has been guilty of misconduct in the discharge of his duties.
- (2) Any person aggrieved by an order of the Deputy Commissioner under sub-section(1) may, within thirty days of the date of the order, appeal to the administrator.
- 64. Any vacancy arising in the office of a member of Village Judicial Council shall be filled by election and the members so elected shall hold office for so long as the member in whose place he has been elected would have held office if the vacancy had not occurred.

CHAPTER - VIII

POWERS OF VILLAGE JUDICIAL COUNCIL

65. A village Judicial Council may exercise such of the powers mentioned in section 66 and 68 as the Administrator may, by general or special order specify
