4	Police	CLOSED	Kindly refer to complaint cum suggestion by shri Pronoy Palk, R/o Garacharma, Port Blair South Andaman. Shri Pronoy Palk has suggested to allow people to carry their two wheelers at Jirkatang and Middle Strait convoy system. He requested to deploy 3 or 4 trucks to transfer two wheeler from one side to the other side of the Jarawa Reserve. It will be convenient for local people as well as tourist. The matter was looked into. Presently four wheelers are allowed to pass through Jarawa Reserve Area form Jirkatang No.2 to Middle Strait and vice versa by convoy system 4 times a day i.e. 0600 hrs, 0900hrs, 1200hrs, 8 1500hrs from Jirkatang No.2 and 0630hrs, 0930hrs, 1230hrs & 1500 hrs from Middle Strait. About 80-100 vehicles move in each convoy. The road is undulating and there are hills and valleys on route. The suggestion of the complainant regarding transportation of two wheelers is not feasible as it will require additional trucks, manpower drivers and police force for regulation.	29/11/2012
