No. AN/PATR / 10 / 1. — In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956 (Regulation No. 3 of 1956), the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is pleased to make the following rules to carry out the purposes of the said Regulation,

CHAPTER I

PRELIMINARY

- 1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT (1) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Rules, 1957.
 - (2) They shall come into force atonce.
- DEFINITIONS In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Deputy Commissioner" except in sub-rule (2) of rule 13 includes an officer authorised by him under section 7 to grant passes;
 - (b) "Form" means Form prescribed in the Schedule appended to these rules;
 - (c) "licence" means a licence granted by the Chief Commissioner under sub-section (1) of section 6 to carry on any trade or business in any reserved area;
 - (d) "licensee" means a person, or a body of individuals including a member or
