

movement of a Hon'ble Judge of the jurisdictional High Court from Port Blair to North and Middle Andaman District is constrained or fettered by the scheduled timing of the convoy system, the total administrative control over the subordinate Courts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands — which is exercised by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta under Article 235 of the Constitution of India — is likely to be compromised. In this context, it may not be out of place to bring to your notice the fact that whenever a Hon'ble Judge of the High Court moves to the North and Middle Andaman District, a police convoy is usually provided separately to the Hon'ble dignitary, notwithstanding the scheduled convoy movement through the Jarawa Reserve.

In such circumstances, the matter is brought to your notice for the purpose of issuance of a special order/instruction to the local authorities which will facilitate free movement of the Hon'ble Judges of the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta through the stretch of Andaman Trunk Road which cuts across the Jarawa Reserve, unhindered and unfettered by the scheduled convoy timing.
