


8.	<b>Involvement of local fishermen of Tirur/wandoor area in Jarawa reserved areas-</b> On 09/06/2015 at 0700 hrs I/c OP Tirur sized 04 Nos Engine dingy, 04 No Oars and 13 person arrested.	Conviction rate be analysed by SDPO Bambooflat and putup.
9.	<b>Destroying kitchen garden of local residents by the Jarawa tribe.-</b> On 17/04/2013 around 0130 hrs group of Jarawa entered in the village of Bakultala and took all the utensils and other house hold items of 05 villagers	Compensation in this case may be examined by DC SA & N&MA as per policy.
10.	<b>Fire caught in Jarawa reserve area.-</b> On 19/04/2016 an information received from AAJVS staff Shri Suk Bahadur stated that Fire Caught at 23 KM near Jarawa Hut	Tribal welfare department may examine to prevent recurrence.
11.	<b>Barter system between Jarawa tribe and local residents -</b> Jarawas do come to settlement area or involved in barter system to satiate their hunger. Jarawas don't get enough food from forests to fulfil their family hunger. It is their hunger leading them to come to settlement areas in search of foods.	(1) Tribal welfare department may examine to formalise the channel of barter system so that such illegal activity can be control. (2) SDPO Bambooflat to gear up intelligence and take strict action.
12.	<b>Stealing of house hold articles by Jarawa tribe -</b> A note along with statement of villagers received from SHO PS Ograbraj vide RD No 2145 dated 06/08/2013 stating therein that on 05/08/2013 a report has been received at OP Tirur that in the intervening night of 04/08/2013 some unknown Jarawas committed theft from the house/shop.	Tribal welfare department may examine.
13.	Empty ambulance on return from Port Blair insists for not following convoy timing.	No permission should be given for empty ambulance to ply without convoy timing.
14.	Two wheelers at Jirkatang is in poor condition which is to be replaced by new motor cycles. One JCB is lying at Jirkatang without use and be returned to PMT. One Gypsy or Camper be replaced with Tata 709 for the use of tail vehicle. One additional four wheeler be issued for patrolling.	SP PMT to put up with ATR
15.	SOVTECH to develop an IT solution for managing the traffic at Jirkatang.	Reference of Aadarsh Gram proposal by Hon'ble MP. Action: SDPO B/Flat
