After inspection of the said area, we met the villagers to enquire about the visit of Jarawas. Some villagers replied that the Jarawas came one year ago, and others said 2-3 years ago. All of them confirmed that the Jarawas came to their place but not frequently. They further said that there is no particular time or season for the Jarawas to enter into their area; they may come at any time.

It has been mentioned in the letter of A.D.M.(S.A) to DM(TW) at flag 'C' that the distance from ATR to the proposed site is approx 5.5 Km, So as mentioned at para 121n it is not included in the Buffer Zone Notification. But as the tour report of ES(AAJVS) at para 127n clearly mentions that Jarawas sometimes visit the area and the report of Talsildar, Farranginj at para 104n also speaks that jarwa tribes visit the proposed place mostly during Summer Season. Hence the District Administration (S.A.) may consider the proposal subject to the condition that the safety and security of jarwas is protected completely.
