ADDENDUM

WHEREAS, the Directorate of Tribal Welfare vide circular No. 1-836/ 2004-TW-TW/421 dated 13.9.2011 has decided that entry of vehicles of all kind into the Jarawa Tribal Reserve be regulated by the Police, in order to protect the interest of the aboriginal Jarawa tribes inhabiting South and Middle Andaman Islands.

WHEREAS, vide Order No. 432 dated 4.10.2012 and Office Memorandum No 1-836/2012-TW/255 dated 14.3.2013, the Dy Commissioner, North and Middle Andaman has been allowed the access of ATR beyond convoy time only for emergency situation like law & order, natural calamities, which should be logged each time at entry point.

NOW THEREFORE, the Competent Authority has decided to allow movement of Ambulance carrying serious referral patients to GB Pant Hospital under escort and rescue/recovery of vehicle in the event of its breakdown within Jarawa Reserve under proper police escort without convoy as exception without quoting/ using it as precedence as a special case.

After from the above, there should not be any dilution of convoy system on ATR.
