ADDENDUM

WHEREAS, the Directorate of Tribal Welfare vide circular No. 1-836/ 2004-TW-TW/421 dated 13.9.2011 has decided that entry of vehicles of all kind into the Jarawa Tribal Reserve be regulated by the Police, ~~in order~~ <sup>in a convoy system</sup> to protect the interest of the aboriginal Jarawa tribes inhabiting South and Middle Andaman Islands.

AND WHEREAS, vide Order No. 432 dated 4.10.2012 and Office Memorandum No 1-836/2012-TW/255 dated 14.3.2013, the Dy Commissioner, North and Middle Andaman has been allowed the access of ATR beyond convoy time <sup>only</sup> for emergency situation like law & order, natural calamities, which should be logged each time at entry points.

NOW THEREFORE, the Competent Authority has decided to allow <sup>the</sup> movement of Ambulance carrying serious referral patients to GB Pant Hospital under <sup>police and also the</sup> escort and rescue/recovery of vehicle in the event of its breakdown within Jarawa Reserve under proper police escort without convoy as exception ~~without quoting/ using it as precedence as a special case,~~ <sup>After from the above, there should not be any dilution of convoy system on ATR.</sup>
