


(13) With regard to the Sentinelese it was mentioned that the Indian Coast Guard shares the information about poachers and others if sighted in the vicinity of North Sentinel Island and then the Police swings into action to apprehend the poachers so that the non-tribals do not exploit the resources available for the Sentinelese and no harm is caused to this tribe.
