Sir,

I am directed to inform you that good amount of plastic and eatable wastages are being found in the Jarawa Tribal Reserve, which is hazardous for the Jarawa tribes. It is due to the wastage thrown by the travelers using the Andaman Trunk Road passing through Jarawa Reserve Area. The matter has been seriously viewed by the Administration. As such, it has been decided that necessary instruction shall be passed to the travelers not to throw any plastic and eatable wastage while crossing through Jarawa tribal reserve.

In this connection, it is requested that necessary directions shall be issued to the travelers through JPP, Jirkatang & Middle Strait not to throw any plastic or eatable wastage while crossing Jarawa tribal reserve via announcement/distribution of pamphlets (copy enclosed). The person who violates must be booked under the relevant section of the A&N (PAT) Regulation, 1956.
