Sir,

Please refer to your letter No. SP(D)/N&MA/MB/10/2018/810 dated 24.5.2018 regarding the incident that occurred on 17.5.2018 at 1700Hrs at Potatang wherein a Jarawa shot an arrow at the front tyre of truck bearing Reg No. AN-01-J-9800 (Neelu Transport) resulting in the its puncture. As you are aware that the Administration has put in place the convoy system for the movement of vehicles in the Jarawa sectors of Andaman Trunk Road (ATR) for the safety and wellbeing not only of the Jarawas but also the commuters. This system is being enforced by the Police.

The traffic on ATR in Jarawa sectors is required to be regulated in such a way that the vehicles move in string without the wide gap in between them. If the vehicles march in close string formation, the Jarawas will not be able to come on ATR to stop the vehicles and indulge in any undesirable activity or interact with travelers which is in the interest of both.


It is therefore, you are requested to ensure the movement of vehicles in close range in string manner on Andaman Trunk Road in the Jarawa sectors.
