Except the Deputy Commissioner, North & Middle Andaman who has been permitted to use the official vehicle outside convoy timings while crossing the tribal reserve area at ATR on emergency like law & order situation and natural calamities etc vide Order No. 432 dated 4.10.2012 (**Flag-B**).
