Sub:- Revision of Convoy timings - regarding.

Sir,

With high sentiment it is intimated that during the visit of Shri-Vivek Rao, IAS, Chief Secretary to Mayabunder on 20-09-2008 I on behalf of general public of North Middle Andaman submitted a 20 point charter of demands in which the revision of convoy timings has also been included. The extract of the charter of demands is given below:-

**XVI. REVISION OF CONVOY TIMINGS:** - As the Govt. officials, PRI's and the general public proceeding from Diglipur, Mayabunder and Rangat to Port Blair have to cross Gandhighat jetty, Baratang jetty and Middle strait jetty. The first convoy starts at 5:30 AM whereas from Middle strait it starts at 6:30 AM daily. I would like to mention the fact that somewhere around 2 ½ -3 hours is required to cover the distance from the convoy (Kadamtala) to Middle strait Gate.

From Kadamtala 15 No. gate to Kadamtala jetty by Vehicle	45 minutes - 1 hour
From Kadamtala jetty to Gandhighat jetty by vehicle ferry	15 - 20 minutes
From Gandhighat jetty to Baratang jetty by vehicle	45 minutes - 1 hour
From Baratang jetty to Middle strait jetty by vehicle ferry	15 - 20 minutes

Therefore if we roughly calculate the required time it comes somewhere around 2 ½ -3 hours. Hence it is practically impossible to reach Middle Strait within one hour.
