Some of our members are regularly transporting, by ATR, live chicken to Rangat, Billiground, Mayabunder and Digliput, for the requirement of the consumers in that area.

Since they are live birds, it is necessary that they reach Rangat before the weather gets too hot otherwise it will result in very high mortality and losses, making it an unviable proposal which will make chicken non-available in those area and cause inconvenience to the general public. This necessitate that the Chicken van is allowed to pass the 6.00 am convoy from Jirkatang. No. 2

We request you to please issue necessary instructions to the concerned authority that vehicle carrying live chicken may be given priority and always allowed to go with the 6.00 am convoy from Jirkatang and also similar instructions may be given for the vehicle ferry at both the creeks.
