Enclosed please find herewith a copy of application made by one Shri.Chittu Singh, Prop. Unitex Adventure, Nayagaon addressed to the Chairman, S.T.A requesting for issue of tourist permit for 'all routes in North, Middle & South Andamans' as a new concept of introducing Limousine Service Luxury Car concept in A&N Islands for improvement of high value tourism.

As per the existing conditions for issue of NOC for Tourist Permit for 'All Routes in North, Middle and South Andaman Districts':

- i) the applicant should be a local person,
- ii) should be below 40 years of age,
- iii) should have own PSV licnese, and
- iv) should not be already in possession of inter-district Tourist Permit or autorikshaw permit for South Andaman.

As per the present procedure S.T.A issue No Objection Certificate at first to the applicants after scrutiny of documents submitted with regard to fulfillment of conditions imposed for every permit. Inspection of parking area is also done before issue of NOC. After getting NOC, they may apply for the permit for which NOC has been issued. Since the above applicant has not furnished any document in support, it is not understood whether he fulfills the above conditions or not.

The Case was therefore put up before the STA in its meeting held on 14.9.2010 and it was decided to get the views of all the three viz. Police, Tourism and Tribal welfare departments in this matter for further consideration of the issue.

It is therefore requested to furnish your views in this regard for placing before the STA in its next meeting for further consideration of the matter.
