This is regarding modification in the schedule of the convoy system on the ATR. It has been mentioned in the Admn.'s letter dated 2.11.2007 at page 31/c that in the meeting held at Raj Niwas on 19th August, 2006, the issue relating to movement of convoys and its timings were came up for discussion and the Transport Department was directed to review the existing schedule of the convoys. The matter was examined by the Transport Department in consultation with IGP and they have decided that the existing schedule of the convoys may be re-adjusted / rescheduled as under:

From Jirktang No.II

- 1. Sixth Convoy at 1130 hours for goods vehicles only may be extended for passenger vehicles also.
- 2. Seventh Convey at 1230 hours may be re-schedule to 1330 hours.

From Middle Strait:

1. Fifth Convey at 1030 hours may be re-scheduled to 1115 hours.

The Assistant Secretary (Transport) had requested to revise the Circular issued under the signature of Secretary (TW) on 15/16th March 2005. The said Circular may please be seen at page 5 /C. The Circular was issued with approval of Lt. Governor vide notes from Para 6 to 10/N above.
