

4.	The Hon'ble High Court has effectively approved the decision of the STA in its meeting on 29.03.2010 holding that the matter of the same day return does not pertain to STA. The Hon'ble High Court has even observed that such a decision of STA has brought about a parity of sorts and done away with any discrimination and even the petitioner have admitted no relief ought to be granted against STA.	No action required.
5.	The Senior Advocate and the Govt. Pleader appearing on behalf of the Administration have assured that if any two operators have been allowed to operate round trip then such authorization peration to be recalled.	The Transport department has not given any such authorization and the matter will be checked in the proposed meeting.
6.	The Hon'ble Court has given a suggestion to be considered by the Administration as contained in para 4 of page 9 of the judgement and reproduced in para 8 at page 2/N.	Such suggestion may be considered in the meeting.

It is therefore requested to kindly take up the matter with CS for fixing the above meeting in view of urgency.
