

management of traffic effective and more efficient. Tribal Welfare and Police Department should also ensure that the provisions of notification No. 210 dated. 21.12.2004 Jarawa Policy are enforced in its true letter and spirit.

It was also decided that the Police Department may submit a status report on the movement and regulation of Traffic on ATR with legal implications along with the size and number of convoys that could be managed by them. Copies of the report may be furnished to PCCF, Secretary (TW), Secretary (Tourism), Deputy Commissioner (SA), Director (Transport) and Director (Shipping) and they may submit with their comments highlighting the issues and problems to be addressed. All the Departments should submit their stand and suggestions immediately to resolve these issues for discussion in the next meeting.
