3. If felt necessary, the A & N Administration may moot an amendment to the PAT Regulations expressly providing for the punishment of any advertisement, direct or indirect, which may induce a person to undertake a visit to these islands.

It is requested that the AAJVS strength in the Jirkatang-Middle Strait sector may be suitably enhanced and the agreed to practice whereby AAJVS staff has to reach the Jarawa hutments along the ATR well in advance before the convoys begin to ensure that the Jarawas do not come on the ATR and are thus shielded from the tourists probing eye be strictly enforced. SP/D South Andaman has also been directed to increase the vigil to ensure the Jarawa Policy in letter and spirit.
