Mr.Banerjee, thereafter, invites attention of the court to the order passed by the learned Single Bench being Order dated 21.12.2006 in WP No.153 of 2006. It appears that the authority concerned imposed an embargo in the use of such permit for the purpose of operation of tourist bus. A resolution was adopted, as reflected from Annexure P.12 at page 59, to the following effect:-</p> <p>"6.
