- At least one Dialysis Machine with expert be placed in Rangat area. There are 04
  machines available in GB Panth Hospital.
- Population of Rangat area is more than the Mayabunder area, referral cases are more in Rangat area hence either CHC of Rangat be upgraded or be declared as District Hospital.
- 4. More specialists are to be posted in North & Middle Andaman District.
- At Kadamtala PHC, Ophthalmic Assistant is not been posted since long back.
   Similarly X-Ray machine operator is not available at PHC Baratang.
- There should be one roster system/schedule of specialists for visiting North & Middle Andaman District.
- NRHM Doctors be deputed to North & Middle Andaman District also.
